

## TYPES OF INCONTINENCE

TYPE	WHAT IS IT?	SUGGESTED PRODUCT
	<b>STRESS</b> Involuntary loss of drips or very small amounts of urine	Bladder Control Pads or Male Guards
	<b>URGE</b> Involuntary loss of urine that occurs after the sensation to void is present, may occur more than 8 times in 24hrs	Bladder Control Pads, Male Guards or Protective Underwear, Adult Briefs
	<b>MIXED</b> Combination of Urge and Stress Incontinence	Bladder Control Pads, Male Guards or Protective Underwear, Adult Briefs
	<b>OVERFLOW</b> Leakage of urine when the bladder reaches a level of fullness causing overflow	Protective Underwear or Adult Briefs
	<b>FUNCTIONAL</b> Cognitive or physical limitation that impacts continence	Depends on the physical function of the individual as to what type of product used, not completely dependent on the amount of leakage

### QUALITY

Disposable incontinence products vary in quality depending on the manufacturer. The use of high quality materials and advanced moisture-wicking capabilities are essential factors in ensuring both the comfort and effectiveness for the wearer.

### SIZE AND FIT

After selecting the appropriate type of product, it is important to determine the correct size. A larger size does not equate to a better fit and more absorbent. Prevail® protective underwear and adult briefs are designed to fit closely to the body, ensuring both protection and comfort for the wearer.

Prevail® sizing charts use height and weight to recommend the size for our products.
